

Directions from Congo Road and I-30 in Benton

Drive time about 30 minutes

Exit I-30 on Congo Road – turn LEFT on Congo if coming from Little Rock and LEFT on Congo if coming from Texarkana.

Go about 3 miles to a “T” (gas station) and turn LEFT on Salem Road.

Go about 4.5 miles (Salem Road will become Congo Ferndale) you will come to Avilla Road (grocery store and hardware store) turn LEFT.

Go about 3 miles (white church) and turn LEFT on Lake Norrell Road.

Lake Norrel road is what we call “the long windy road”. You only have to go about 3 miles but it feels longer.

You will come to the intersection of Lake Norrell and North Lake (there is a small log cabin bus stop and a community bulletin board) turn RIGHT on North Lake (the locals call it North Lake Norrell but it is North Lake).

Go two streets and turn LEFT on Bobwhite Circle.

Bobwhite Circle is a windy little road but you are almost here. You will make a sharp right turn and go up a steep little hill and on top of the hill turn LEFT on Bobwhite Trail. There are a bunch of mail boxes below the street sign.

Bobwhite Trail is a gravel road (not on the map) – the sign is for friends to find us.

Stay to the LEFT on the gravel road – 50 yards

Our house is the one with the two Cypress columns.

Parking is in the driveway of the house to the left (last house). This house belongs to Lillian Dee’s mother – Betty
