

## Directions from Little Rock

About 35 minutes from 430 and Colonel Glenn

Take 630 to 430 South and exit Colonel Glenn.

Turn RIGHT on Colonel Glenn and go .6 of mile and turn LEFT on Lawson Road – small gas station.

Go about 13 miles and turn RIGHT on Lake Norrell Road (Stop sign and white church)

Lake Norrell road is what we call “the long windy road”. You only have to go about 3 miles but it feels longer.

You will come to the intersection of Lake Norrell and North Lake (there is a small log cabin bus stop and a community bulletin board) turn RIGHT on North Lake (the locals call it North Lake Norrell but it is North Lake).

Go two streets and turn LEFT on Bobwhite Circle.

Bobwhite Circle is a windy little road but you are almost here. You will make a sharp right turn and go up a steep little hill and on top of the hill turn LEFT on Bobwhite Trail. There are a bunch of mail boxes below the street sign.

Bobwhite Trail is a gravel road (not on the map) – the sign is for friends to find us.

Stay to the LEFT on the gravel road – 50 yards

Our house is the one with the two Cypress columns.

Parking is in the driveway of the house to the left (last house). This house belongs to Lillian Dee’s mother – Betty
